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I. Overview of Inventive Step



A claimed invention is considered to involve an inventive step if, having regard to the prior art, it is not obvious to a person skilled in the art. (PCT guidelines 13.01)

Who is "a person skilled in the art"?

A hypothetical person having <u>ordinary skill</u> in the art, who is aware of <u>common general knowledge</u> in the art at the relevant date, and has access to everything in the prior art. (PCT guidelines 13.11)

What is "obvious"?

The claimed invention is obvious <u>if the person skilled in the art on the</u> relevant date would have been motivated or prompted to realize the claimed invention by substituting, combining, or modifying one or more of those items of prior art with a reasonable likelihood of success.(PCT guidelines 13.03, 13.09)
