

Part III How to Represent the Form by Features

In the application for design registration, a wide ranging forms of a wide ranging articles can be requested. Therefore, there are some cases where the rules described in “Basics of the Statement in Applications” and “Basics of the Statement in Drawings” in Part I do not specifically explain how to represent them. In addition, Part I does not mention the special method of fully representing a design under the constraint of the prescribed format, such as the size of the drawing.

Here in Part III, it will be explained how to represent the design of special forms for which basic rules do not provide enough information, and therefore, it is difficult to figure out how to represent them.
