

11. Wooden toys or building blocks

Since wooden toys or building blocks are articles designed to be repeatedly built and disassembled, it is necessary to depict both the form of each constituent piece of the article and the form of the assembled state on the drawing. (Format No.6 Note (19))

- (i) As for building blocks, it is necessary to prepare “a set of six views” for each constituent piece of the article, as well as drawings necessary to specify the form of the assembled state.
- (ii) As for wooden toys, it is necessary to prepare “a set of six views” for the assembled state, as well as drawings to specify the entire form of each constituent piece of the article.
