
How to Describe a Sound Trademark in an Application (by use of a staff in combination with words)

1. Main paragraph of Article 3(1) of the Trademark Act

A sound trademark consisting of a combination of musical elements that can be presented in the form of a staff and sounds that cannot be presented in the form of a staff (e.g., sounds in nature, sounds made by animals, electronic sounds) can be presented in the following manner.

(Example) Trademark presented by use of a staff in combination with words)

[Trademark for which trademark registration is sought]



This trademark consists of the sounds expressed in the aforementioned staff followed by electronic sounds imitating the mewing of a cat. The sounds of the trademark lasts about X seconds as a whole.
