


Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH)

- If a patent application has been determined to be patentable in OFF (RO), the corresponding application is qualified for accelerated examination in OSF (DO)
- > PPH offers global patent procurement with low pendency and low cost for applicants / Reduction of search and examination duplication and improvement of quality for patent offices





The PPH network





Advantages of PPH

(1) Expeditious examination & Cost effectiveness

Expeditious examination and Cost saving due to decreasing number of office actions



Advantages of PPH (2) Reduction of FA pendency

For PPH application, FA pendency is greatly reduced.

From JPO to USPTO:

<not using PPH> 25 months (from application to FA) (As of July 2009)


<using PPH> 2-3 months (from grant of PPH request to FA)

From USPTO to JPO:

<not using PPH> 28.5 months (from application to FA) (As of 2008(FY))

<using PPH> 2-3 months (from grant of PPH request to FA)

In the case where OFF is JPO, OSF is USPTO:





Advantages of PPH (3) High grant rate

- ➤ If a patent application has been determined to be patentable in OFF, the corresponding application has high grant rate in OSF
- ➤ More stable patent right through examinations by OFF and OSF for the same invention

Case: OFF is JPO, OSF is USPTO

Grant rate of all applications in USPTO


Grant rate of PPH applications (OFF: JPO, OSF: USPTO)

Requirements, Required Documents etc. for PPH -Case of PPH request from JP to U.S.-

	1. The U.S. application is in certain relation with the JP application. Ex.) The U.S. application is a Paris Convention application validly claiming priority to one of more applications filed in the JPO
Requirements	2. JPO application has at least one claim that was determined by the JPO to be allowable/patentable.
	3. All the claims in each U.S. application sufficiently correspond or are amended to sufficiently correspond to the allowable/patentable claims in JP applications.
List of Required Documents	 A copy of all claims and its English translations A copy of the latest JPO office actions (other than "Decision to Grant a Patent") and its English translation Copies of all cited documents* Claims Correspondence Table * Submission of U.S. patents, U.S. patent application publications, or other documents that are submitted for IDS is not required.
Procedures after grant of PPH requirement	Fast track the examination.
Fee for PPH request	Free (from 25th May 2010)

As a rule, requirements for PPH are similar to other offices. Please see the comparative table between countries in reference materials and PPH guidelines of each country for details.
