

LIU YijunJudge, The Intellectual Property Court of Beijing, China

Liu, Yijun is a judge of Beijing Intellectual Property Court. He respectively received his master's degree from China University of Political Science and Law (Civil and commercial Law) and from City Uninversity of Hongkong (Common law), and received his Ph.D. (Intellectual Property Law) from China University of Political Science and Law. He has heard intellectual property cases since 2014, and issued over 1500 judgments, some of which were selected as Excellent cases or Top Ten Typical Intellectual Property Cases of the Year by Beijing High people's Court, one of his academic papers was awarded the second prize of excellent cases analysis by the Supreme people's Court of China.
