



Summary of declarations

Article 5(2)(b)(ii): Brief description of the characteristic features

Article 7(2): Individual designation fee

Article 13(1): Special requirements concerning unity of design

Article 16(2): Supporting documents for a change in ownership

Article 17(3)(c): Maximum duration of protection of 15 years

Rule 9(3)(a): Certain views of the design required

Rule 18(1)(b): 12-month refusal period

Rule 18(1)(c)(i): Date of effect - extension up to 6 months

Rule 18(1)(c)(ii): Unintentional communication after the 12-month refusal period



Brief description as additional mandatory content | Article 5(2)(b)(ii)

An international application designating China shall contain a brief description of the characteristic features of the design.

The characteristic features mean shape, pattern or their combination, or the combination of color with shape or pattern, or the position, which are different from prior design.

The characteristic features can be described in 2 ways:


- •The characteristic features lie in shape, pattern or their combination, or the combination of color and shape or pattern.
- •The characteristic features lie in a part of the product incorporating the claimed design.

















Here are three examples of how to describe the characteristic features:

- •The characteristic features lie in shape of the shoe as shown.
- •The characteristic features lie in the combination of color and shape of the shoe as shown.
- •The characteristic features lie in the shoe upper.





Individual designation fee under the 1999 Act | Article 7(2)

In connection with an international application in which China is designated, and in connection with the renewal of such international registration resulting from such an international application, the prescribed designation fee shall be replaced by an individual designation fee.

Certain views of the design required | Rule 9(3)(a)

The declaration referred to in Rule 9(3)(a) of the Common Regulations, whereby "for each international application designating China, so far as a product with a three dimensional design is concerned, or the essential features of the design of the product concern a Graphical User Interface (GUI) only, the applicant shall submit the compliant view(s) of the product".

Specific requirements on priority | Article 3



If the applicant fails to, within the prescribed time limit, submit the copy of the earlier application documents, or fails to submit the relevant certifying documents, or fails to pay or fully pay the priority claim fee, it shall be deemed that the right of priority has not been claimed.


