### Procedures to file a request to the JPO (Japan Patent Office) for Patent Prosecution Highway Pilot Program between the JPO and the DGIP (Directorate General of Intellectual Property)

Applicants can request accelerated examination by a prescribed procedure including submission of relevant documents on an application which is filed with the JPO and satisfies the following requirements under the JPO-DGIP Patent Prosecution Highway pilot program based on the DGIP application.

When filing a request for the PPH pilot program, an applicant must submit a request form "Written explanation of the needs of the accelerated (appeal) examination" based on the procedure prescribed in "Guidelines for the Accelerated Examination and Accelerated Appeal Examination for Patent Applications." Under the PPH pilot program, an applicant is not required to fill in the section "2. the disclosure of prior arts and comparison between the claimed invention and prior art" in "Written explanation of the needs of the accelerated (appeal) examination".

The offices may terminate the PPH pilot program if the volume of participation exceeds manageable level, or for any other reason. Ex ante notice will be published if the PPH pilot program is terminated.

The PPH pilot program will be in effect for three (3) years commencing on January 1, 2024 and will end on December 31, 2026. However, the program may be extended after a joint DGIP-JPO review and assessment of the program implementation.

### 1. Requirements

(a) Both the JPO application on which PPH is requested and the DGIP application(s) forming the basis of the PPH request shall have the same earliest date (whether this be a priority date or a filing date).

For example, the JPO application (including PCT national phase application) may be either:

- (I) an application which validly claims priority under the Paris Convention from the DGIP application(s) except for a complex priority (examples are provided in ANNEX, Figures A, B, C, H, I and J), or
- (II) an application which provides the basis of a valid priority claim under the Paris Convention for the DGIP application(s) (including PCT national phase application(s)) (examples are provided in ANNEX, Figures D and E), or
- (III) a PCT national phase application where both the JPO application and the DGIP application(s) are derived from a common PCT international application having no

priority claim (an example is provided in ANNEX, Figures K, L, M, and N).

### (b) Patent applications have been initiated in the Office of the DGIP or the JPO.

Patent applications belong to a patent family of which at least the earliest application was filed with the JPO or the DGIP acting as a national office (an example of the application which does not comply with this requirement is provided in ANNEX, Figures F and G).

The JPO application which validly claims priority to direct PCT applications is also eligible.

### (c) At least one corresponding application exists in the DGIP and has one or more claims that are determined to be patentable/allowable by the DGIP.

The corresponding application can be the application which forms the basis of the priority claim, an application which derived from the DGIP application which forms the basis of the priority claim (e.g. a divisional application of the DGIP application), or an DGIP national phase application of a PCT application.

Claims are "determined to be allowable/patentable" when the DGIP examiner clearly identifies the claims to be allowable/patentable in the latest office action, even if the application is not granted for patent yet. The office action may be either:

- (i) Decision to Grant a Patent
- (ii) Notification of Reasons for Refusal
- (iii) Decision of Refusal
- (iv) Appeal Decision

### (d) All claims on file, as originally filed or as amended, for examination under the PPH must sufficiently correspond to one or more of those claims indicated as allowable in the DGIP.

Claims are considered to "sufficiently correspond" where, accounting for differences due to translations and claim format, the claims in the JPO are of the same or similar scope as the claims in the DGIP, or the claims in the JPO are narrower in scope than the claims in the DGIP.

In this regard, a claim that is narrower in scope occurs when an DGIP claim is amended to be further limited by an additional feature that is supported in the specification (description and/or claims).

A claim in the JPO which introduces a new/different category of claims to those claims indicated as allowable in the DGIP is not considered to sufficiently correspond. For example, where the DGIP claims only contain claims to a process of manufacturing a product, then the claims in the JPO are not considered to sufficiently correspond if the JPO claims introduce product claims that are dependent on the corresponding

process claims.

Any claims amended or added after the grant of the request for participation in the PPH pilot program need not to sufficiently correspond to the claims indicated as allowable in the DGIP application.

(e) The JPO has not begun examination of the application at the time of request for the PPH (an example is provided in ANNEX, figure O).

### 2. Documents to be submitted

Documents (a) to (d) below must be submitted by attaching to "Written explanation of the needs of the accelerated (appeal) examination".

Note that even when it is not needed to submit documents below, the name of the documents must be listed in "Written explanation of the needs of the accelerated (appeal) examination" (Please refer to the Example form for the detail).

(a) Copies of all office actions (which are relevant to substantial examination for patentability in the DGIP), which were sent for the corresponding application by the DGIP, and translations of them<sup>2</sup>.

Either Japanese or English is acceptable as translation language.

(b) Copies of all claims determined to be patentable/allowable by the DGIP, and translations of them<sup>2</sup>.

Either Japanese or English is acceptable as translation language.

#### (c) Copies of references cited by the DGIP examiner

If the references are patent documents, the applicant doesn't have to submit them because the JPO usually possesses them. When the JPO does not possess the patent document, the applicant has to submit the patent document at the examiner's request. Non-patent literature must always be submitted.

The translations of the references are unnecessary.

### (d) Claim correspondence table

The applicant requesting PPH must submit a claim correspondence table, which indicates how all claims in the JPO application sufficiently correspond to the patentable/allowable claims in the DGIP application.

When claims are just literal translation, the applicant can just write down that "they are

the same" in the table. When claims are not just literal translation, it is necessary to explain the sufficient correspondence of each claim based on the criteria 1. (d) (Please refer to the Example form).

When the applicant has already submitted above documents (a) to (d) to the JPO through simultaneous or past procedures, the applicant may incorporate the documents by reference and does not have to attach them.

## 3. Example of "Written explanation of the needs of the accelerated (appeal) examination" for filing request an accelerated examination under the PPH pilot program

### (1) Circumstances

When an applicant files a request for an accelerated examination under the PPH pilot program to the JPO, an applicant must submit a request form "Written explanation of the needs of the accelerated (appeal) examination" based on the procedure prescribed in "Guidelines for the Accelerated Examination and Accelerated Appeal Examination for Patent Applications "3.

The applicant must indicate that the application is included in (I) to (III) of 1. (a), and that the accelerated examination is requested under the PPH pilot program. The application number, publication number, or a patent number of the corresponding DGIP application(s) also must be written.

\*In the case that the application which has one or more claims that are determined to be patentable/allowable is different from the DGIP application(s) included in (I) to (III) of 1. (a) (for example, the divisional application of the basic application), the application number, publication number, or a patent number of the application(s) which has claims determined to be patentable/allowable and the relationship between those applications also must be written.

#### (2) Documents to be submitted

The applicant must list all required documents mentioned above 2. in an identifiable way, even when applicant omits to submit certain documents.

### (3) Notice






## A case meeting requirement (a) (I) - Paris route -

## A case meeting requirement (a) (I) - PCT route -









### A case meeting requirement (a) (I)

- PCT route, Domestic priority -



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


### A case meeting requirement (a) (II) - PCT route -
















# A case meeting requirement (a) (III) - Direct PCT route -




# L A case meeting requirement (a) (III) - Direct PCT & Paris route -


